NEIGHBORHOOD WORKDAY A SUCCESS.

Many thanks to the almost 30 neighbors who volunteered part or all of their Saturday, February 13, 1982 to help improve the Optimist Park.

The Indian Head/Lehigh Neighborhood Association, with the support and cooperation of the Tallahassee Parks and Recreation Department, made the

following improvements to the building and the park:

Painted the interior walls and trim of building; Purchased, made, and hung the curtains; Spread new sand around tot-lot; Edged tot-lot and cleaned up the immediate area; Planted dogwoods and border grass around the oak trees on the southside of the building; Removed old pyracanthas and dead trees from park grounds; Pressure cleaned basketball court, portions of the sidewalks and exterior of the building.

These efforts are part of the neighborhood pilot program, initiated by your neighborhood association, to improve the park for the betterment of all.

OUR FIRST YEAR IN REVIEW

The Indian Head/Lehigh Neighborhood Association has just completed it's first year as an official organization. What a first year it has been! From an idea shared by a couple of residents we have grown to an incorporated association with nearly 200 members.

Some of the activities and accomplishments during the past year were: The successful challenge and subsequent modification to the proposed development adjacent to the neighborhood to the southeast; A grand "Picnic in the Park" last spring; The passage of a pilot project by the City Commission to try a joint park revitilization project between the Neighborhood Association and the City Parks Department; Christmas Caroling in the neighborhood; A workday in the Optomist park to clean up the grounds and improve the scout house; and many other instances of friendly exchange between neighbors.

Without the wonderful support of our members, none of this would have been possible. Congratulations and Thanks from the Board of Trustees.
