LOVE YOUR DOG--LEASH IT!

According to city ordinances (Section 5-35) it is unlawful for you to allow your dog to run at large anywhere in the city—and it can cost you money in fines, along with impoundment of your dog. Female dogs in heat must be confined securely to avoid contact with another dog, except for planned breeding (Section 5-36). You could be fined \$25.00 for violation.

Every day pets are injured in traffic, stolen, poisoned or creating unwanted litters. They soil property, dump trash cans, cause accidents and bite people. Our pets don't have a sense of civic responsibility, so we must think for them.

So remember, confine or leash your dog, have him wear tag identification (cats, too!) and prevent unwanted litters! If you have questions about pet care, Ann Kemp of the local Humane Society is available to assist you (488-9060 or 877-3419).
