INDIANHEAD RESIDENT ON IMPORTANT COMMITTEE REGULATING GROWTH

In 1986 the state legislature required that all counties and cities start planning in order to begin controlling the rapid growth that Florida is experiencing. The Tallahassee-Leon County Local Planning Agency (LPA) is composed of 10 citizens appointed by the city and county comissioners to prepare and recommend an expanded comprehensive plan for our community. City Comissioner Steve Meisburg appointed past IHLNA President Roxanne Dow to the LPA.

In addition to familiarizing itself with state, regional and local requirements, the LPA is inviting citizens to participate in a "Futures Conference" on January 8th and 9th at the Florida State Conference Center. This conference is intended to solicit our visions of the future of our community. The conference is free, so if you are interested in how we grow in the future, this is your chance to do something about it.
